ORDINANCE NO. 9827

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Goodwin Parcels A and B to King County Water District No. 111.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Goodwin Parcels A and B to King County Water District No. 111 was filed with the county council effective November 30, 1990.
- King County Water District No. 111 has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 256-9-90 concurred with the proposed annexation.
- King County Water District No. 111 filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated September 13, 1990, on the proposed annexation.
- The county council held a public hearing on the  $\frac{\mathcal{H}_{\mathcal{L}}}{\mathcal{L}}$ , 19  $\frac{9}{1}$  and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 111 of the area known as Goodwin Parcels A and B and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Goodwin Parcels A and B.

SECTION 2. King County Water District No. 111 is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.
