AN ORDINANCE adding one judicial position to Northeast district court, amending Ordinance 3714, Section 3; Ordinance 9427, Section 7; and K.C.C. 2.68.070; and 2.68.078.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3714, Section 3, as amended and K.C.C. 2.68.070 are hereby amended to read as follows:

King County District Court - Organization.

A. NAME AND BOUNDARIES OF THE COURT: There shall be a single district court within the boundaries of King County which include to the centerline of Puget Sound and all of the current city of Bothell as a joint district court district established pursuant to RCW 3.38.060 and named the District Court of the State of Washington in and for the district of King County.

B. NUMBER OF JUDGES TO BE ELECTED: Twenty-((five)) six full time judges.

C. POPULATION: 1,413,900.

D. LOCATION OF CENTRAL OFFICE: King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

E. LOCATION OF OTHER COURTROOMS: There are ten court facilities within the unified district located as follows:

1. Aukeen, located within the City of Kent.
2. Bellevue.
3. Federal Way.
4. Issaquah.
5. Mercer Island.
6. Northeast, located within the City of Redmond.
7. Renton.
8. Seattle.
9. Shoreline, located within the Shoreline community planning area.

1 10. Southwest, located in the vicinity of Burien with
 2 additional facilities in the vicinity of Vashon business
 3 district.

4 F. LOCATION OF RECORDS: Administrative records shall be
 5 maintained at the central office or as designated by the
 6 presiding judge. Court records shall be located at the
 7 respective court facilities or as otherwise designated by the
 8 presiding judge.

9 G. DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONERS TO BE AUTHORIZED: The
 10 number and location of district court commissioners shall be as
 11 currently authorized, together with such additional court
 12 commissioners as the district court may require.

13 H. DEPARTMENTS INTO WHICH THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL BE
 14 INITIALLY ORGANIZED, INCLUDING MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS: (Courts
 15 facilities to which assigned are indicated within parenthesis).
 16 Cities of Algona, Auburn, Kent (Aukeen); Bellevue, Clyde Hill,
 17 Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point (Bellevue); Issaquah, North
 18 Bend, Snoqualmie (Issaquah); Mercer Island, (Mercer Island);
 19 Bothell, Carnation, Kirkland, Redmond, Skykomish (Northeast);
 20 and Normandy Park (Southwest).

21 SECTION 2. Ordinance 9427, Section 7 and K.C.C. 2.68.078
 22 are hereby amended to read as follows:

23 Number of judges elected in each electoral district. The
 24 number of judges to be elected in each of the electoral
 25 districts within the single King County District Court shall be
 26 as follows:

4 SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be
 5 effective upon the effective date of Engrossed HB 1467 as
 6 enacted by the Fifty-Second Legislature. In the event that
 7 Engrossed HB 1467 does not become law this ordinance shall be
 8 null and void and of no legal consequence.
