STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 15th Avenue South hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement has been granted to Rainier Vista Sewer District.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified "C Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on 50% of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from the records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$3,753.00 from the petitioners. This amount was determined by multiplying the vacation area by 50% of the assessed value per square foot of the adjoining properties.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County council on the ______ day of ______, 19_7/____.
