AN ORDINANCE approving the invitation to bid for financial services for the period from October 1, 1991 through September 30, 1994, and requesting that the King County Executive study the feasibility of linking county financial services to a provider's past community reinvestment performance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of K.C.C. 4.14, the Invitation To Bid for Banking and Safekeeping Services as modified by Addenda Nos. 1 and 2, are hereby approved as shown in Attachments A, B and C.

SECTION 2. The King County Executive shall study the feasibility of linking banking and safekeeping contracts, and the deposit of County funds, to a provider's past performance of re-investing funds in the local community. The study should evaluate the feasibility of establishing performance indicators to be used as selection criteria when selecting financial service providers. Performance indicators to be evaluated should include, but not be limited to, participation in government sponsored affordable housing programs, and participation in government sponsored economic development programs.

For banking services contracts in particular, the study should address the feasibility of expanding the current evaluation criteria for community reinvestment performance. Evaluation criteria to be studied should include, but not be limited to:

- A) Home Mortgage Disclosure Act data by census tract;
- B) Disclosure of small business lending by census tract;
- C) Branch deposit balance totals by census tract;
- D) Disclosure of housing related defaults and foreclosure rates by census tracts;
