AN ORDINANCE approving the Highline Water District 1989 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On November 9, 1988, the Highline Water District (known prior to January 22, 1991 as Water District 75 and hereafter referred to as the Highline Water District) made a declaration of non-significance regarding its comprehensive water system plan.

On February 7, 1990, the Board of Commissioners of the Highline Water District passed Resolution No. 90-27-E adopting the 1989 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On October 24, 1990, the Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Highline Water District 1989 Comprehensive Water System Plan as amended by the addition of Appendix H: June 26, 1991 letter regarding development of a water conservation plan element, is hereby approved on condition that a water conservation plan element be transmitted to the council in the form of a water system plan amendment prior to December 31, 1992.
