- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified "C Class" and in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, as amended by Ordinance No. 3088 and Ordinance No. 9164, the compensation due King County is based on 50% of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from the records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of a check for \$1,068.00 from the petitioners. This amount was determined by multiplying the vacation area by 50% of the assessed value per square foot of the adjoining property.
