AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation to several surface water management funds for purposes of repairing damages as a result of the November 1990 heavy rains, amending Ordinance 9720, Sections 36, 39, 61, 62, 94 and 95, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated and adopted the following supplemental appropriations to pay for damages resultant from November 1990 heavy rains and flooding as follows: \$1,315,043 is appropriated to river improvements from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (\$907,190), from the unappropriated green river flood control zone district fund balance (\$35,815), from the special programs, executive contingency fund balance (\$305,148), and from the unappropriated river improvement fund balance (\$46,890); \$196,632 is appropriated to surface water management from Federal Emergency Management Agency (\$68,109), from the City of Federal Way (\$4,338), and from the unappropriated surface water management fund balance (\$124,185); \$26,000 is appropriated to the McAleer Creek Mitigation CIP Project No. 047083 from savings from the McAleer Regional Pond CIP Project No. 047005 (\$15,800), and from the unappropriated surface and stormwater construction fund balance (\$10,200); \$30,000 is appropriated to the Summerfield Phase I CIP Project No. 047081 from the unappropriated surface and stormwater construction fund balance (\$30,000).

SECTION 2. Ordinance 9720, Section 36, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
