ORDINANCE NO. **10031**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$487,860 to the emergency medical services for paramedic training and related start-up costs associated with placing a new paramedic (Medic One) unit in South King county; amending Ordinance 9720, Section 66, as amended.

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$487,860 from the undesignated Emergency Medical Services Fund balance to emergency medical services to cover the costs of paramedic training and vehicle purchase associated with placing a new unit in service in South King County.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 66, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) - From the Emergency Medical Services Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Provided that:

The purchase of the paramedic vehicle be deferred until after the council reviews and approves the concept of adding a 10th paramedic unit. The council will make its final determination after reviewing the EMS Master Plan.
