ORDINANCE NO. **10068**

AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste disposal rates and amending Ordinance 5231, Section 1 as amended, and K.C.C. 10.12.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5231, Section 1, and K.C.C.

10.12.020 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Fees for use of disposal sites. All persons using county-operated solid waste disposal facilities shall pay the service fees set forth in the following schedules:

A. (~~Through December 31, 1991,~~) Effective January 1, 1992, service fees for the use of disposal sites with scales, excluding Cedar Hills, shall be:

1. Solid waste disposal:

Passenger licensed vehicles.....(~~\$ 6.50~~) \$ 9.25  
per entry

Other vehicles.....(~~\$47.00~~) \$66.00  
per ton

Charitable Organizations ..... \$43.00 per ton

Minimum Charge.....(~~\$ 6.50~~) \$ 9.25  
per vehicle

Charitable Organizations, Minimum Charge.....\$ 6.00  
per entry

2. Deposit of source separated yard waste at disposal sites with yard waste facilities:

Passenger licensed vehicles.....(~~\$ 4.00~~) \$ 7.50  
per entry

Other vehicles.....(~~\$31.00~~) \$58.00  
per ton

Minimum Charge.....(~~\$ 4.00~~) \$ 7.50  
per vehicle

1 B. Effective January 1, 1992 service fees for the use of  
 2 disposal sites without scales shall be based upon the cubic  
 3 yard or fraction thereof as follows:

4 1. Solid waste disposal:

5 Passenger licensed vehicles.....(~~(\$ 6.50)~~) \$ 9.25  
 6 per entry

7 Other vehicles

8 Compacted wastes.....(~~(\$14.00)~~) \$19.00  
 9 per cubic yard

10 Uncompacted wastes.....(~~(\$ 8.00)~~) \$11.00  
 11 per cubic yard

12 Minimum charge.....(~~(\$ 6.50)~~) \$ 9.25  
 13 per vehicle

14 2. Deposit of source separated yard waste at disposal  
 15 sites with yard waste facilities:

16 Passenger licensed vehicles.....(~~(\$ 4.00)~~) \$ 7.50  
 17 per entry

18 Other vehicles

19 Compacted wastes.....(~~(\$ 9.60)~~) \$17.00  
 20 per cubic yard

21 Uncompacted wastes.....(~~(\$ 5.25)~~) \$ 9.50  
 22 per cubic yard

23 Minimum charge.....(~~(\$ 4.00)~~) \$ 7.50  
 24 per vehicle

25 C. Effective January 1, 1992 service fees at the Cedar  
 26 Hills Landfill shall be:

27 Cedar Hills regional direct.....(~~(\$31.50)~~) \$43.00  
 28 per ton

29 Other vehicles.....(~~(\$47.00)~~) \$66.00  
 30 per ton

31 Disposal by other vehicles is at the discretion of the  
 32 solid waste manager. Any certificated hauler who has been  
 33 disposing solid waste at a rural landfill may be authorized by  
 34 the solid waste manager to dispose solid waste at the Cedar

1 Hills Regional Landfill on a temporary, emergency basis at the  
2 regional direct fee.

3 D. Effective July 1, 1991, a moderate risk waste  
4 surcharge shall be added to all solid waste disposed by non-  
5 solid waste collection entities using county operated disposal  
6 facilities. The fee schedule is as follows:

7 1. For sites with scales:

- 8 Self-Haulers.....\$ 2.61 per ton
- 9 Minimum Charge.....\$ 1.00 per entry
- 10 Passenger Licensed Vehicles.....\$ 1.00 per entry

11 2. For sites without scales:

- 12 Compacted.....\$ .76 per cubic
- 13 yard
- 14 Uncompacted.....\$ .44 per cubic
- 15 yard
- 16 Minimum Charge.....\$ 1.00 per entry
- 17 Passenger Licensed Vehicles.....\$ 1.00 per entry

18 E. Effective January 1, 1992 a special waste fee shall be  
19 charged for special wastes including infectious waste treated  
20 and handled pursuant to King County board of health Code  
21 10.28.070, asbestos-containing waste material, bulky waste,  
22 problem wastes, and other additional wastes requiring  
23 clearances pursuant to the King County Board of Health Code  
24 Title 10 or pursuant to rules promulgated by the Department.

- 25 Special Waste Fee.....(~~(\$75.00)~~) \$100.00
- 26 per ton
- 27 Minimum Charge.....(~~(\$10.50)~~) \$13.75
- 28 per entry

29 F. In the absence of exact weights or measurements, the  
30 estimate of the manager shall be binding upon the user.

31 G. Special Service Fee. Solid waste generated and/or  
32 collected within the boundaries of a jurisdiction which has not  
33 entered into an agreement with King County for use of King  
34 County solid waste disposal facilities as provided by this  
35 chapter may only be disposed of in a King County facility upon

1 payment of a special service fee of three times the applicable  
2 per ton rate set forth above for facilities with scales and  
3 three times the applicable cubic yard rate set forth in  
4 subsection B for compacted or uncompact waste for facilities  
5 without scales. Payment of the special service fee in this  
6 subsection shall be in lieu of payment of the fees in  
7 subsections A - ((HD)) E. Nothing in this subsection  
8 authorizes the use of King County facilities by any municipal  
9 corporation or agent thereof or any commercial hauler for  
10 disposal of solid waste generated and/or collected outside King  
11 County.

12 ((H. ~~Effective date. Effective February 1, 1990, a~~  
13 ~~monthly transfer shall be made from the Energy/Resource~~  
14 ~~Recovery Fund to Solid Waste Operating Fund. The amount of the~~  
15 ~~transfer shall be determined by adding the following:~~

16 1. ~~The number of tons of solid waste disposed at the~~  
17 ~~Basic Fee multiplied by \$7.00.~~

18 2. ~~The number of tons of solid waste disposed at the~~  
19 ~~Cedar Hills Regional Direct Fee multiplied by \$4.50.~~

20 3. ~~The number of tons of source separated yard waste~~  
21 ~~disposed at the Yard Waste Fee multiplied by \$7.00.))~~
