AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of portions of Southeast 80th Street and 120th Avenue Southeast in Council District No. 6 - V-2069 Petitioners: Leslie A. Donner, c/o Coal Creek Parkway, Inc. and Others

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of those portions of Southeast 80th Street and 120th Avenue Southeast hereinafter described.
- 2. Portions of rights-of-way vacated by this ordinance will be replaced by new roadways to be dedicated in the proposed plat of Dorchester Ridge (S89P0155).
- 3. The department of public works has been advised that easements are not needed at this time as necessary easements will also be dedicated in the plat.
- 4. The building and land development division and the roads and engineering division recommended approval of the vacation of 120th Avenue Southeast as the proposed plat of Dorchester Ridge contains a right-of-way design which replaces 120th Avenue Southeast and provides a connection between Southeast 80th Street and Southeast 84th Street. King County is in receipt of three quitclaim deeds conveying the replacement roadway to the county. In the event that the plat of Dorchester Ridge is not approved, these deeds will be recorded.
- 5. The building and land development division and the roads and engineering division also recommended approval of the request to vacate approximately the east 240 feet of Southeast 80th Street as the topography in this area appears to be too steep for road construction.
- 6. The petition for vacation has been modified, however, in response to access concerns of nearby property owners and a request from the building and land development division. All portions of Southeast 84th Street and 122nd Avenue Southeast referenced in the petition have been removed from consideration.
- 7. The roads and engineering division also opposed vacating the south two feet of Southeast 80th Street lying westerly of 120th Avenue Southeast. This right-of-way is presently fifty-eight feet in width and reducing the width to fifty-six feet would not be in the best interest of the public.
- 8. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

9. The value of the vacation area was calculated to be \$16,082.50. The right-of-way is classified "C Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on 50% of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from the records of the department of assessments. The King County council has determined that the dedication of replacement right-of-way in the plat of Dorchester Ridge is sufficient to meet the compensation requirements of King County Code 14.40.020.

The portion of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:

120th Avenue Southeast (Dorchester Street) lying Southerly of the South margin of Southeast 80th Street (6th Avenue) and lying Northerly of the North margin of Southeast 84th Street (Main Street).

EXCEPT any portion thereof lying within the margins of 119th Avenue Southeast/121st Avenue Southeast road alignment as proposed within the plat of Dorchester Ridge (S89PO155).

Also EXCEPT the West half of 120th Avenue Southeast (Dorchester Street) lying South of the South margin of 119th Avenue Southeast/121st Avenue Southeast road alignment as proposed within the plat of Dorchester Ridge (S89P0155).

TOGETHER WITH all of Southeast 80th Street lying Westerly of the Northerly extension of the East line of Lot 2, Block 4 of C.D.
