ORDINANCE NO. **10081**

AN ORDINANCE designating a portion of
Coal Creek Parkway as an engine
compression brake control area and adding
a new section to Ordinance No. 10070

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is added to ordinance No. 10070 a
new section to read as follows: Coal Creek Parkway engine
compression brake control area.

The following area is hereby designated as an engine
compression brake control area pursuant to Section 1, Ordinance
10070: From the northwest and northeast corners of the
right of way at the intersection with Interstate 405 and Coal
Creek Parkway, thence southeast along both the east and west
margins of the right-of-way of Coal Creek Parkway to the
Bellevue city limits on the intersection of the right-of-way of
S.E. 48th Place if extended westerly.
