Dear Councilmember North:

I am approving the enclosed ordinance which disappropriates \$104,768 from the radio shop remodel CIP, Project No. 666236. The remaining appropriation of \$71,994 is considered adequate to complete phase I of the project based on the revised scope of work and cost estimate provided by Facilities Management as concurred with by the Motor Pool Fleet Manager. The subject ordinance does not disappropriate \$104,768 from the \$138,146 appropriated in the 1991 Motor Pool ER&R Fund Adopted Budget, which represents the funding source for the Radio Shop Remodel CIP Project No. 666236. Generally, these funds could have been disappropriated. However, I agree that they should remain intact. The Motor Pool ER&R Fund 1991 Adopted Budget is currently running short of spending authority to repair and maintain the existing Motor Pool fleet properly. The Budget Division intends to initiate a budget revision up to \$104,768 to cover these costs in lieu of requesting a supplemental appropriation ordinance.

I believe this will meet with your approval, because it resolves a budget problem with a minimum of paperwork and processing time at year end 1991.
