ORDINANCE NO. **10146**

1
2 AN ORDINANCE establishing strategies to
3 assist youth and their families in
4 positive and constructive efforts to
5 avoid late night dangers and to increase
6 parenting and youth coping skills by
7 establishing a pilot program distributing
8 informational pamphlets to troubled youth
9 and parents.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. There is hereby established a pilot program to
12 test the effectiveness of distributing informational pamphlets
13 to troubled youth and parents. The pamphlets shall be
14 distributed by police officers to youth who are on the streets
15 late at night or who otherwise appear to be in need and to the
16 parents of these youth if they are returned to their homes.
17 The pamphlets shall also be widely distributed to youth and
18 social service agencies, pediatric and obstetric hospitals and
19 clinics, public offices and libraries, and any other
20 informational conduits for youth and their families.

21 The pamphlets shall list the addresses and telephone
22 numbers of agencies where youth and parents can find
23 professional help and guidance for matters such as dependence
24 on alcohol or other drugs; physical, sexual or emotional abuse;
25 neglect; medical care, including care for sexually transmitted
26 diseases; educational opportunities, including remedial
27 education; temporary shelter, food and clothing; parenting
28 education programs; and counseling to regain emotional health
29 and stability.

30 SECTION 2. This pilot program shall be tested in the
31 north and south portions of the county. The executive shall
32 consult with private non-profit agencies in designing the

1 program and developing the pamphlets and shall report on the
2 effectiveness of the program no later than October 30, 1992.
