AN ORDINANCE appropriating funds for the purpose of paying to the City of Seattle solid waste disposal fee revenues which were dedicated to energy/resource recovery and capital equipment replacement funding, and amending Ordinance 9720, Section 94, Attachment No. 1 as amended.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with the provisions as set forth in Ordinance 9304, Sections 5 and 6, as amended the County acknowledges that the City of Seattle has, on September 28, 1990, satisfactorily met the requirements of notifying the County of its intent to withdraw from the County's solid waste disposal system by June 1, 1991. Pursual that ordinance the County must refund to the City of Pursuant to Seattle solid waste disposal fee revenues dedicated to energy/resource recovery and capital equipment replacement funding.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,699,098 from the unappropriated fund balance of the Solid Waste Energy/Resource Recovery Fund and an appropriation of \$749,911 from the unappropriated fund balance of the Solid Waste Capital Equipment Replacement Fund to pay the City of Seattle solid waste disposal fee revenues dedicated to energy/resource recovery and capital equipment replacement funding consistent with Ordinance 9304, Sections 5 and 6.

Section 2. Ordinance 9720, Section 94, as amended is hereby amended to read as follows:
