ORDINANCE NO. **10147**

2 AN ORDINANCE appropriating funds for the  
3 purpose of paying to the City of Seattle  
4 solid waste disposal fee revenues which  
5 were dedicated to energy/resource  
6 recovery and capital equipment  
7 replacement funding, and amending  
8 Ordinance 9720, Section 94, Attachment  
9 No. 1 as amended.

10 PREAMBLE:

11 In accordance with the provisions as set forth in  
12 Ordinance 9304, Sections 5 and 6, as amended the County  
13 acknowledges that the City of Seattle has, on September  
14 28, 1990, satisfactorily met the requirements of notifying  
15 the County of its intent to withdraw from the County's  
16 solid waste disposal system by June 1, 1991. Pursuant to  
17 that ordinance the County must refund to the City of  
18 Seattle solid waste disposal fee revenues dedicated to  
19 energy/resource recovery and capital equipment replacement  
20 funding.

21 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

22 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an  
23 appropriation of \$3,699,098 from the unappropriated fund  
24 balance of the Solid Waste Energy/Resource Recovery Fund and an  
25 appropriation of \$749,911 from the unappropriated fund balance  
26 of the Solid Waste Capital Equipment Replacement Fund to pay  
27 the City of Seattle solid waste disposal fee revenues dedicated  
28 to energy/resource recovery and capital equipment replacement  
29 funding consistent with Ordinance 9304, Sections 5 and 6.

30 Section 2. Ordinance 9720, Section 94, as amended is  
31 hereby amended to read as follows:

1 From the several capital improvement project funds there  
2 are hereby appropriated and authorized to be dispersed the  
3 following amounts for the specific projects identified in  
4 Attachment No. 1 of this ordinance.

9 Provided that:

10 The payments to the City of Seattle contemplated by this  
11 ordinance shall not be made until the City of Seattle provides  
12 in writing a statement that confirms there are no financial  
13 claims outstanding related to its withdrawal from the King  
14 County solid waste system, except for any interest accruing for  
15 the above payments.
