ORDINANCE NO. **10155**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$271,063 to implement the King County anti-gang strategy, and amending Ordinance No. 9720, Section 17 and 36, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a \$271,063 appropriation to the department of public safety; and a disappropriation of \$271,063 from special programs - executive contingency, to implement the King County anti-gang strategy.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 17, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PUBLIC SAFETY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Safety	\$271,063

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Public Safety shall be: 1.0

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 36, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

Special Programs - Executive Contingency (\$271,063)

SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is

2 health or safety or for the support of county government and
3 its existing public institutions.
