

ORDINANCE NO. **10169**

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County parks and recreation facilities and amending Ordinance No. 5225, Sections 2(A), (B), (C), as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020, .030, .040 and Ordinance No. 9227, Section 1(Part), as amended and K.C.C. 7.08.025

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2 (A), as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:

Damage deposit \$25.00 to \$200.00

(determined by type of activity and number of participants)

Key deposit \$25.00 to \$50.00

(determined by type of activity and number of participants)
