## ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to paid parking in County owned parking facilities; and amending Ordinance 8753, Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7; Ordinance 354, Sections 2 and 5; and K.C.C. Sections 3.32.005, 3.32.010, 3.32.040, 3.32.045, 3.32.055, and 3.32.090.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 8753, Section 4 and K.C.C. Section
3.32.005 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Location. County automotive parking facilities shall refer to the parking spaces found in the following areas:

- A. County automotive center, 5th and Jefferson.
- B. County courthouse, 3rd and James.
- C. County adult detention center, 5th and James.
- D. Open surface lots located at 5th and Jefferson, and on Yesler.
- E. Yesler Building.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 3511, Section 2 and K.C.C. Section 3.32.010 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Administrative Regulations. Administrative regulations adopted by the department of executive administration shall include, but not be limited to the following subjects:

- A. Identification of positions eligible for ((assigned))
  reserved and unreserved parking;
  - B. Regulation of after-hours and weekend parking:
- C. Enforcement procedures, including certification and monitoring of carpools, and the establishment of procedures for handling complaints;
  - D. Designation of the public parking area;
- E. Prohibition of the resale of the parking stall
  assignment((+));
- F. Designation of reserved and unreserved parking areas.
- SECTION 3. Ordinance 3511, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. Section 3.32.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

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Public Parking area. Parking space will be established for public parking to be used in conjunction with county 2 business. ((Said parking shall be limited to two hours.)) 3 Members of the public on county business shall be charged for 4 all time parked. ((in the event the two-hour free-limit is 5 exceeded.)) Exceptions can be made if they meet explicit 6 criteria for exemptions established in accordance with Section 7 3.32.010 and monitored by the King County auditor. 8 SECTION 4. Ordinance 8753, Section 6, as amended, and 9 K.C.C. Section 3.32.045 are hereby amended to read as follows: 10 Parking rates - surface parking lots. The parking rates 11 for parking in designated open surface parking lots shall be as 12 follows: 13 14

A. Daily ((general)) parking ((on county business which exceeds the two hour limit, general public parking not on county business, and county employees not assigned regular parking stalls)):

1. Effective January 1, 19((89)) 92:

0 - 2 hours		\$3.00
2 - 4 hours		\$5.00
4 - 10 hours		\$7.00
Special events	(( <del>\$6.00</del> ))	\$7.00

## PROVIDED THAT:

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((No-c)) County employees not permanently assigned to a downtown work station shall pay no more than ((\$60.00)) \$75.00 in any calendar month for such unassigned parking.

- Evenings after 6 p.m. and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays except during special events \$4.00
- Special events rates conditions. Special events rates shall apply after 6 p.m. weekdays and all day Saturday, Sunday and legal holidays and shall apply during those events designated in accordance with Section 3.32.010. Parking for special events shall be provided in surface lots and in the county automotive center, provided that county employees who pay for parking privileges in the automotive center shall be exempted from payment of the special event fee.

25	All county employees who are not assigned the use of a

29	weekends shall pay \$10.00 per month.		
30	The executive will notify 2nd and 3rd shift employees of		
31	the availability of escort service.		
32	SECTION 6. Ordinance 8753, Section 7 and K.C.C. Section		
33	3.32.090 are hereby amended to read as follows:		
34	Parking fee revenues - disposition. All revenues derived		
35	from parking fee <u>s</u> (( <del>rates</del> )) shall be (( <del>used to pay the</del>

2	retirement for the automotive center.)) distributed as follows:		
3	(( <del>PROVIDED THAT</del> :))		
4	All parking revenues derived from the increase of parking		
5	rates for covered and uncovered effective on or after		
6	January 1, 1989 shall be reserved for the support of health and		
7	human services activities and shall be deposited in the Health		
8	and Human Services Set-aside Fund.		
9	PROVIDED THAT:		
10	All revenue derived from elimination of free public		
11	parking, and all revenue derived from second and third shift		
12	unreserved parking by county employees and from occasional		
13	after-hours and weekend parking from county employees, shall be		
14	deposited in the Current Expense fund.
