

ORDINANCE NO. **10193**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$288,308 to the department of adult detention from special programs - executive contingency to support attorneys' fees related to the settlement of the Hammer et al. v. King County lawsuit; and amending Ordinance No. 9720, Sections 36 and 42, as amended and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$288,308 to the department of adult detention from special programs - executive contingency to support attorneys' fees related to the settlement of the Hammer et al. v. King County lawsuit.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 36, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

Special Programs - Executive Contingency (\$288,308)

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 9720, Section 42, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ADULT DETENTION - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Adult Detention \$288,308

SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
