## ordinance no. 10236

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election to determine whether an area known as Burien shall be incorporated as a non-charter code city and declaring an emergency.

## PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 35A.03 of the Revised Code of Washington, a petition for incorporation as a non-charter code city, signed by qualified voters resident within the limits of the proposed city equal in number to ten percent of the votes cast in the proposed area at the last preceding general state election has been presented to the Records and Elections Division.

The petition for incorporation states: that the form of government under which the proposed city will operate in the event it is incorporated shall be Council-Manager, sets forth the proposed boundaries of the proposed corporation, states that the name shall be the City of Burien and that the number of inhabitants therein as nearly as may be, is 38,000 and prays that it may be incorporated.

The Superintendent of Elections has determined that the petition for incorporation does not violate the prohibitions contained in RCW 35.02.010 with regard to number of inhabitants and that there are a sufficient number of valid signatures on the petition.

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.93.100 the Boundary Review Board (BRB) invoked jurisdiction and in accordance with RCW 36.93.160 on December 12, 1991, filed its written decision approving with modifications the proposed incorporation. No appeal has been filed.

Pursuant to Chapter 29.13.010 and RCW 35.02.078, the council deems an emergency exists for the purpose of calling a special election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Boundary Review Board has deemed the matter of an election for incorporation of Burien approved as of December 12, 1991.

SECTION 2. The name of the proposed city shall be the City of Burien.

SECTION 3. The official population of the proposed City of Burien, if incorporated, shall be 27,610.

SECTION 4. A special election shall be held on the 10th day of March 1992, within the area of the proposed City of Burien, as hereinafter described, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors the determination of whether it shall

be incorporated as a non-charter code city, under the Council-Manager plan of government proposed in the petition. 2 The ballot title shall be as directed by SECTION 5. 3 statute. 4 The boundaries of the territory proposed for SECTION 6. 5 annexation are hereby described as follows: 6 Beginning at the northeast corner of the proposed City of Burien, the point of origin of the boundary description, which 7 is the intersection of the west margin of Des Moines Memorial 8 Drive South (Des Moines Way South) and the north margin of 9 10 South 128th Street said point being also on the city limits of SeaTac as established by King County Ordinance 8820 and situated in the SW1/4 Section 9, Township 23 North, Range 4 11 12 13 East, W.M., King County, Washington; 14 Thence southerly and westerly along the west boundary of 15 the City of SeaTac as established by said Ordinance 8820, which 16 is the western margin of Des Moines Memorial Way South (Des 17 Moines Way S) to its intersection with the Southwest margin of 18 State Route 509 as located in the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 Section 19 29, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M; 20 Thence continuing southerly along said margin of State 21 Route 509 and boundary of the City of SeaTac as established by 22 said Ordinance 8820 to its intersection with the southwesterly 23 margin of aforementioned Des Moines Memorial Drive South (Des Moines Way South) as located in the SW 1/4 of the NE1/4 of 24 25 Section 32, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; 26 Thence northwesterly along the southwesterly margin of Des 27 Moines Memorial Drive South (Des Moines Way South) to its 28 intersection with the southeast margin of Normandy Road as 29 located in the NW1/4 of the NW 1/4 Section 32, Township 23 30 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; 31 Thence along said margin of Normandy Road to its intersection with the southeasterly extension of the southwest 32 33 margin of Ambaum Blvd. South; Thence northwesterly along said extension and the western 35 margin of Ambaum Blvd. South to the intersection with the 36 southern margin of South 174th Street; 37 Thence westerly along the Southern margin of South 174th 38 Street to the east margin of 1st Avenue South; 39 Thence north along said east margin to the north line of the SW1/4 of Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.; 40 41 Thence west along said north line to the NW corner of said 42 subdivision; 43 Thence continuing west along the north line of the SE1/4 44 of Section 30, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. to the 45 west margin of 1st Avenue South; 46 Thence north along the west margin of 1st Avenue South 30 47 feet more or less to the north boundary line of the City of 48 Normandy Park as established by Resolution 14030; 49 Thence west along the north boundary line of the City of 50 Normandy Park as established by Resolution 14030 to the east 51

margin of 10th Avenue Southwest;

Thence north along said east margin 30 feet more or less to the north margin of SW 168th Street;

Thence west along said north margin of SW 168th Street to its intersection with the northerly extension of west line of lot 1 Block 1 of Assessors Plat of Normandy Park Highlands as recorded in Volume 47 of Plats pages 33 and 34 records of King County, said lot and block being located in the NE1/4 of the SE1/4 of Section 25, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M.;

Thence south along said extension and west line and its southerly extension to the north margin of SW 170th Street;

Thence west along said north margin to the center line of 22nd Avenue SW;

Thence south along said centerline of 22nd Ave. SW 30 feet more or less to its intersection with the city limits of Normandy Park as established by Ordinance 30;

Thence continuing in a generally southeasterly direction along said established city limits of Normandy Park to the north line of Gov Lot 4 of the SE1/4 Section 25, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M.;

Thence easterly along the city limits of Normandy Park to the east line of said Section 25;

Thence south along said city limits of Normandy Park and east line of Section 25 to the SE corner of Section 25;

Thence west along said city limits of Normandy Park and the south line of Section 25 to the easterly shore of Puget Sound;

Thence westerly to the centerline of the east passage of Puget Sound;

Thence northerly along said centerline of the east passage of Puget Sound to its intersection with the southwesterly extension of Seattle's city limits as depicted as the extension of the Northwest line of lot 3 Block 498 of Seattle Tide Lands Extension No. 1 as located within the NW1/4 Section 12, Township 23 North, Range 3 East, W.M.;

Thence northeasterly along said extension and city limits of Seattle to the east margin of Seola Beach Drive SW;

Thence continuing northeasterly along said east margin to the north line of Gov Lot 3 of said Section 12;

Thence east along said north line of Gov Lot 3 to the west margin of 30th Avenue SW;

Thence north 30 feet to the north margin of SW 116th Street;

Thence east along the north margin of SW 116th Street to the intersection of the eastern margin of 12th Avenue SW;

Thence south along the east margin of 12th Ave SW to the eastern margin of Ambaum Blvd. SW;

Thence southerly along the eastern margin of Ambaum Blvd. SW to the intersection of the north margin of SW 128th Street;

Thence east along the north margin of the SW 128th Street and So. 128th Street to the intersection of the western margin of Des Moines Memorial Drive South, which is the point of origin.

EXCEPT that area thereof being a portion of the City of Normandy Park as established through the Bonniewood Annexation, more particularly described as follows:

The Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 30, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

Together with the Southerly 510.7 feet of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of said Section 30;

Together with the Westerly 45 feet of the Southerly 1832 feet of the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

And except the following described parcel:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of section 30, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

Thence South 89 degrees 01'18" West along the South line of said Northeast quarter 45 feet more or less, to the Westerly margin of 1st Avenue South, and the true point of beginning;

Thence continuing South 89 degrees 01'18" West along the South line thereof, 646 feet; thence North 5 degrees 05'42" West, 30.08 feet; thence North 89 degrees 01'18" East 648.18 feet, to the westerly margin of 1st Avenue South; thence South 0 degrees 55'40" East, along said Westerly margin, 30 feet to the true point of beginning.

SECTION 7. The notice of election shall be published as required by law.

SECTION 8. The election shall be conducted pursuant to Chapter RCW 35.02.

SECTION 9. As provided in RCW 29.36.120 and King County Motion 7393, the King County council requests the manager of records and election to conduct the election by mail.

2	declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is
3	necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,
4	health or safety or for the support of county government and
5	its existing public institutions.
6	SECTION 11. The manager of the division of records and
7	elections is directed to send a voters pamphlet which contains
8	the statements in favor or against the incorporation of the
9	registered voters within the area legally described in this
10	ordinance.
