ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation to the City of Des Moines, adoption of the proposed zoning regulation enacted in the City of Des Moines Ordinance No. 816, and assumption of a pro-rated portion of existing voter-approved indebtedness, within an area contiguous to the City known as "North Hill Annexation Area", requesting it to be held by mail, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. The City of Des Moines, Washington, by Resolution No. 673 has determined that it is in the public interest, health, safety and general welfare to provide for annexation of an area known as North Hill Annexation Area in accordance with Chapter 35A.14.015 RCW.
- 2. Said resolution does satisfy the provion of RCW 35A.14.010 for qualification for annexation.
- 3. The City of Des Moines, by Resolution No. 673, December 5, 1991, concurs in the annexation of the area known as North Hill Annexation Area as provided by RCW 35A.14.050.
- 4. Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.93.100, the Boundary Review Board (BRB) did not invoke jurisdiction and in accordance on January 26, 1992, filed its written decision approing the proposed annexation as submitted.
- 5. In the event that the Boundary Review Board invokes jurisdiction by January 26th, this ordinance is null and void.
- 6. Pursuant to RCW Chapters 29.13 and 35A.14, the council deems an emergency exists for the purpose of calling a special election.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 10th day of March, 1992, in accordance with RCW 35A.14.050 to be held within the territory of the proposed annexation, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters within said territory the questions of annexation, zoning and assumption of indebtedness.

SECTION 2. The number of registered voters within the subject area is found to be 731.

SECTION 3. The ballot title, as directed by statute, should be substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION:

- FOR ANNEXATION OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, ASSUMPTION OF A PRO-RATED PORTION OF EXISTING VOTER-APPROVED INDEBTEDNESS, AND ADOPTION OF THE PROPOSED ZONING REGULATION ENACTED IN CITY OF DES MOINES ORDINANCE NO. 816.

- AGAINST ANNEXATION

<u>SECTION 4.</u> The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of South 216th Street, with the East margin (projected) of Des Moines Memorial Drive, said point being located in the Northwest 1/4 Section 8, Township 22N, Range 4E, W.M. King County and the true point of beginning of this description;

Thence Northwesterly and Northeasterly along said East margin of Des Moines Memorial Drive to the North margin of South 208th Street;

Thence Westerly along said North margin of South 208th Street to the East margin of First Avenue South (SR-509);

Thence Southeasterly, Northeasterly, and Easterly along the East margin of First Avenue South (SR-509) and the North margins of South 216th Place (SR-509) and South 216th Street (SR-509) respectively to the Southwest corner of Lot 17, Block 13 of Southern Pacific Land Company's Second Addition to Des Moines, as recorded in Volume 4 of Plats, Page 49, records of King County, Washington;

Thence in a Southeasterly direction to a point five feet East of the Northwest corner of Block 4, Town of Des Moines, as recorded in Volume 3 of Plats, Page 165, Records of King County, Washington, said point being on the Southerly margin of South 216th Street and Des Moines city limits as established by Ordinance No. 774;

Thence Easterly along said South margin adn continuing along said city limits to its intersection with the center line of vacated 7th Avenue South;

Thence Easterly along the extension of said center line to its intersection with the center line of 216th St.;


Thence Easterly along said center line of South 216th Street, to its intersection with the East margin (projected) of Des Moines Memorial Drive and the T.P.O.B. of this description.

SECTION 5. The notice of election shall be published as required by law.

SECTION 6. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
