ORDINANCE NO. **10245**

AN ORDINANCE directing the manager of the division of records and elections to send a voters pamphlet for the regional housing levy and other ballot measures scheduled for the March 10, 1992 election, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The manager of the division of records and elections is directed to send a voters pamphlet which contains the statements in favor or against the regional housing levy and other ballot measures for the March 10, 1992 election as established in Ordinance 10235.

SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
