ORDINANCE NO.

10275

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2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Board of
3 Appeals and Equalization, reducing the
4 number of members which constitute a
5 quorum in matters of appeals from
6 executive orders and regulations from
7 five to four and amending Ordinance No.
8 6444, Section 2 and K.C.C. 2.34.020.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Ordinance 6444, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.34.020

11 are hereby amended as follows:

12 Composition. A. In conformance with Section 710 of the
13 charter, the board shall be composed of seven members appointed
14 by the county executive subject to confirmation by a majority
15 of the county council.

16 B. The term of office shall be for four years, and shall
17 be staggered as follows: two terms shall commence each year
18 except that every fourth year commencing in 1986 only one term
19 shall commence. Board members shall fill the term to which
20 appointed or that portion remaining of an unexpired term. A
21 member whose term has expired shall continue to serve until a
22 successor has been appointed. Terms shall commence on July
23 1st.

24 C. Removal of a member of the board, except upon
25 expiration of his appointed term, shall be only as provided for
26 in Section 710 of the charter.

27 D. The members of the board shall meet and choose a
28 chairman annually to serve from July 1st to June 30th of the
29 following year.

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E. A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum in matters of equalization (~~however five members shall constitute a quorum~~) and in matters of appeal from executive orders and regulations.
