AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of the annexation of the City of Normandy Park to King County Fire Protection District No. 2, and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Normandy Park by adoption of Ordinance 541 has determined that the public interest will be served by the annexation of the city to King County Fire Protection District No. 2 and stated its intent to join the district. The commissioners of the district have concurred in the annexation and have transmitted notice thereof to the King County Council together with the request that a special election be held on April 7, 1992 on a ballot proposition authorizing the annexation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on April 7, 1992, in accordance with RCW 52.04.071 to be held in the City of Normandy Park and King County Fire Protection District No. 2. The ballot proposition, in accordance with the provisions of RCW 52.04.071 shall be in substantially the following form:

"Shall the City of Normandy Park be annexed to and be a part of King County Fire Protection District No. 2?

YES.....[ ]

NO.....[ ]

SECTION 2. Notice of election shall be published as required by law.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, or safety or for the support of county government and






