AN ORDINANCE calling for separate elections to be held to nominate and elect persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Burien, which will be a noncharter code city.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. On March 10, 1992, a special election was held pursuant to King County Ordinance No. 10236 on the question of whether the area known as Burien should be incorporated as a noncharter code city.

SECTION 2. On March 20, 1992, the King County canvassing board certified the results of the March 10th special election on the question of incorporation, certifying that the proposed incorporation of the area known as Burien had been approved.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078, the county council hereby calls for the manager of the division of records and elections to hold separate elections to nominate and elect persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the City of Burien, based on its population and the fact that Burien will be a noncharter code city with a councilmanager form of government.

SECTION 4. The primary election to nominate candidates for these elective positions shall be held at a special election occurring on Tuesday, May 19, 1992, as required by RCW 29.13.020.

SECTION 5. Following the primary election on May 19, the manager of records and elections shall conduct a special election to fill these elective positions to be held on September 15, 1992 pursuant to RCW 35.02.078-.090.

SECTION 6. Both elections shall be conducted by the manager of records and elections in accordance with all
