

ORDINANCE NO. **10310**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$167,000 to the Criminal Justice Fund and totaling \$50,000 to other various county agencies for the purchase from the City of Seattle of certain microwave path improvements associated with a county-wide emergency radio system and authorizing the executive to enter into an interagency agreement which transfers these funds to the City of Seattle, amending Ordinance No. 10182, Sections 59, 78, and 79, as amended, and adding a new section to Ordinance 10182.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted appropriations of \$167,000 to the Criminal Justice Fund from the Criminal Justice Fund balance; \$33,350 to the County Road Fund, \$13,900 to the Solid Waste Fund, and \$2,750 to the Airport Fund balances for the purchase from the City of Seattle of certain microwave path improvements associated with a county-wide emergency radio system.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 59, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ROADS OPERATING - From the County Road Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Roads Operating \$33,350

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 78, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SOLID WASTE - From the Solid Waste Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Solid Waste \$13,900

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 79, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

1 AIRPORT - From the Airport Fund there is hereby
2 appropriated to:

3 Airport \$2,750

4 NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. There is added to Ordinance No.
5 10182 a new section to read as follows:

6 CRIMINAL JUSTICE - From the Criminal Justice Fund there is
7 hereby appropriated to:


8 Public Safety/Special Program \$167,000

9 NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. The executive is authorized to
10 enter into an interagency agreement with the City of Seattle
11 which transfers \$217,000 in county funds to Seattle for the
12 purpose of expanding the northend microwave system in order to
13 provide sufficient capacity to accommodate the radio traffic
14 which will be generated when the county implements its portion
15 of a regional emergency radio system. It is understood that
16 the cost of this system will be redistributed among
17 participating agencies when the county implements its portion
18 of the emergency radio system. Authorization to execute this
19 agreement is subject to approval of the final interagency
20 agreement by the chair of the fiscal management and health and
21 human services committee.


