AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of Mrs. N.J. Gosnell Road (S.E. 82nd Street) in Council District No. 3 - V-2023 Petitioners: Bruce and Kathleen McLeod and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting the vacation of that portion of Mrs. N.J. Gosnell Road described as Parcel A.
- 2. The various utilities serving the area have been notified of the pending vacation. Puget Sound Power and Light Company has been granted an easement through the vacation area.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The roads and engineering division has determined that, in the vicinity of the proposed vacation, the existing Mrs. N.J. Gosnell Road is not in the same location as the original right-of-way established in 1921. The area occupied by the existing roadway was awarded to the petitioners in a property line settlement in the Superior Court of the State of Washington, File No. 82-2-05384-8.
- 5. The department of public works has requested, as a condition of the vacation, that the petitioners replace the right-of-way to be vacated with the area occupied by the existing roadway. The real property division is in receipt of a warranty deed granting the existing roadway to King County. The deed will be recorded when the vacation of the original right-of-way is finalized.
- 6. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the original right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 7. The original right-of-way is classified "C Class." In accordance with Ordinance No. 2759, as amended by No. 3088, compensation of \$200.00 for administrative costs has been received.

Said road being described as an easement for ingress and egress 30 feet wide, known as Mrs. N.J. Gosnell Road, said road commences at a point on the North and South centerline of Section 32, Township 24 North, Range 7 East, W.M., King County, Washington, said point being 1030 feet more or less South of the North 1/4 corner of said Section 32, and runs in a Westerly and Northwesterly direction to a point near the Northwestern corner of said Section 32 pursuant to the Order of Establishment of Mrs. N.J. Gosnell Road, dated November 21, 1921,
