ORDINANCE NO: ~~10322~~

AN ORDINANCE relating to the date for the special election on the proposed incorporation of the area known as Woodinville and the special primary election of persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Burien, confirming and ratifying Ordinances 10306 and 10307, and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW Title 35.02, RCW 29.13.010, and RCW 29.13.020, on March 16, 1992 the King County Council passed Ordinances 10306 and 10307 calling, respectively, for a special election on the proposed incorporation of the area of King County known as Woodinville and for a special primary election of persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Burien.

Both ordinances referenced above call for the elections to take place on May, 19, 1992 pursuant to the anticipated passage into law of Engrossed Senate Bill 6213, amending RCW 29.13.010 and RCW 29.13.020 to provide for special elections on the third Tuesday in May. On March 26, 1992 Senate Bill 6213 was signed into law by the Governor of the State of Washington, effective immediately.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Consistent with Engrossed Senate Bill 6213, signed into law by the Governor on March 26, 1992 and effective immediately, Ordinance 10306 calling for a special election on May 19, 1992 on the question of the proposed incorporation of the area known as Woodinville, and Ordinance 10307 calling for a special primary election on May 19, 1992 of persons to fill the various elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Burien are hereby ratified, confirmed, and in all respects approved.

SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or
