AN ORDINANCE relating to cable communications, granting the extension of a cable television franchise to Edmonds Cable Company.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. Edmonds Cable Company currently holds cable television franchise number 563 granted by King County. That franchise expired on February 13, 1992.
- 2. County staff have discussed renewal of the franchise with the franchisee; however, no agreement has been reached.
- 3. Edmonds Cable Company has requested that its franchise be extended.
- 4. The county wants to extend the franchise to facilitate an orderly review of franchise renewals.
- 5. The council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant the franchise extension listed below.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council hereby grants Edmonds Cable Company an extension of franchise number 563 until June 18, 1992.

SECTION 2. The extension is granted subject to the condition that if within thirty (30) days of the council's passage of this ordinance Edmonds Cable Company fails to sign a franchise extension agreement in substantially the form contained in Exhibit A which is attached to and a part of this

2 deemed to be denied and any extension granted by this ordinance
3 shall be null and void.

EXHIBIT A

FRANCHISE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Edmonds Cable Company currently holds franchise number 563 granted by King County, Washington for the operation of a portion of its cable television system in unincorporated King County; and

WHEREAS, this franchise expired on February 13, 1992; and

WHEREAS, Edmonds Cable Company has requested that this franchise be extended; and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until June 18, 1992 through the passage of Ordinance No. _____ subject to the conditions contained in the ordinance and this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, King County, Washington and Edmonds Cable Company agree as follows:

- 1. The term of King County cable television franchise number 563 is hereby extended so that it will now expire on June 18, 1992.
- 2. All other conditions of King County cable television franchise number 563 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified by this agreement or by Ordinance No. _____.
- 3. King County and Edmonds Cable Company agree that neither party waives any rights currently possessed regarding renewal of franchise number 563 by the signing of this agreement.
