AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$353,277 to the division of alcoholism and substance abuse from additional funds available from State, Federal and miscellaneous grants; and amending Ordinance No. 10182, Section 68, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$353,277 to the division of alcoholism and substance abuse from additional funds available from State, Federal and miscellaneous grants.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 68, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE - From the Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Fund, there is hereby appropriated to:

PROVIDED THAT:

The Executive reports to the fiscal management and human services committee on a quarterly basis client outcomes achieved by jail model drug abuse treatment programs funded by the federal Office of Treatment Improvement (OTI). Such outcomes should include but not be limited to:

- rebooking rates;
- program statistics compiled from OTI funded programs;
- number of inmates with completed mental and physical health assessments and number of referrals for Community Mental Health services; and
- number of inmates who have completed vocational training.

3 treatment system outcomes based on data generated by the state.
