ORDINANCE NO. **10340**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the interim appointment of the director of the office of citizens complaints, amending Ordinance 473, Section 5, as amended, and K.C.C. 2.52.050, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 473, Section 5, as amended and K.C.C. 2.52.050 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Term of Office. The director shall serve for a term of five years, unless removed by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the county council upon their determination that he has become incapacitated or has been guilty of neglect of duty, misconduct or political activity. The council may appoint an interim director pending the appointment of a new director whenever the term of the director has expired or the office otherwise becomes vacant.

SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
