ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to capital facilities planning as part of the county's comprehensive planning policies; adopting on an interim basis the parks facilities subelement of the capital facilities element of the comprehensive plan; and adding a new section to KCC 20.12.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The following new section is added to KCC 20.12:

Parks and low-income housing plans may be adopted as subelements of the capital facilities element of the comprehensive plan until such time as the county completes its adoption of a new comprehensive plan under the provisions of the Growth Management Act, as amended.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. The following new section is added to KCC 20.12:

The parks development policies adopted by Ordinance 1096, as amended and codified in KCC 20.12.090, and the King County Open Space Plan adopted by Ordinance 8657 and codified in KCC 20.12.380, together with the Parks Capital Improvement Program adopted annually as part of the county's budget process and the Three Year Parks Capital Improvement Program Funding Plan for 1992 to 1995, which is incorporated herein by reference and attached as Attachment A, constitute the parks facilities subelement of the capital facilities element of the comprehensive plan, until such time as the county completes its adoption of a new comprehensive plan under the provisions of the Growth Management Act, as amended.
