- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of Northeast 85th Street hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The petitioners have provided King County with a warranty deed to a thirty foot by thirty foot area at the northwest corner of existing tax lot 022506-9054. King County is also retaining a thirty foot access easement at the east end of the vacation property. These areas are for anticipated future road needs.
- 6. The right-of-way is classified "C Class" and in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, as amended by Ordinance No. 3088 and Ordinance No. 9164, the compensation due King County is based on 50% of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from the records of the department of assessments. In consideration of the unique circumstances surrounding this vacation action, and the granting of the aforementioned deed to King County, monetary consideration in the amount of \$1438.00 is hereby waived.
