## ordinance no. <u>103</u>52

AN ORDINANCE relating to district court boundaries, amending Ordinance 3714, Sections 3 and 20, and K.C.C. 2.68.070 and 2.68.180 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 3714, Section 3, as amended and K.C.C. 2.68.070 are hereby amended to read as follows:

King County District Court - Organization.

A. NAME AND BOUNDARIES OF THE COURT: There shall be a single district court with boundaries of all the area within the boundaries of King County which include to the centerline of Puget Sound and all of the current city of Bothell as a joint district court district established pursuant to RCW 3.38.060 and named the District Court of the State of Washington in and for the district of King County. These boundaries include the Canyon Park annexation to the City of Bothell effective April 30, 1992.

- B. NUMBER OF JUDGES TO BE ELECTED: Twenty-five full time judges.
  - C. POPULATION: 1,413,900.
- D. LOCATION OF CENTRAL OFFICE: King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.
- E. LOCATION OF OTHER COURTROOMS: There are ten court facilities within the unified district located as follows:
  - 1. Aukeen, located within the City of Kent.
  - 2. Bellevue.
  - 3. Federal Way.
  - 4. Issaquah.
  - 5. Mercer Island.
  - 6. Northeast, located within the City of Redmond.
  - 7. Renton.
  - 8. Seattle.

- 9. Shoreline, located within the Shoreline community planning area.
- 10. Southwest, located in the vicinity of Burien with additional facilities in the vicinity of Vashon business district.
- F. LOCATION OF RECORDS: Administrative records shall be maintained at the central office or as designated by the presiding judge. Court records shall be located at the respective court facilities or as otherwise designated by the presiding judge.
- G. DISTRICT COURT COMMISSIONERS TO BE AUTHORIZED: The number and location of district court commissioners shall be as currently authorized, together with such additional court commissioners as the district court may require.
- H. DEPARTMENTS INTO WHICH THE DISTRICT COURT SHALL BE INITIALLY ORGANIZED, INCLUDING MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS: (Courts facilities to which assigned are indicated within parenthesis). Cities of Algona, Auburn, Kent (Aukeen); Bellevue, Clyde Hill, Hunts Point, Medina, Yarrow Point (Bellevue); Issaquah, North Bend, Snoqualmie (Issaquah); Mercer Island, (Mercer Island); Bothell, Carnation, Kirkland, Redmond, Skykomish (Northeast); and Normandy Park (Southwest).

SECTION 2. Ordinance 3714, Section 20, as amended and K.C.C. 2.68.180 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Northeast electoral district - Boundaries. The legal boundaries of the Northeast electoral district shall be:

All of the area within the following described line:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of

King County and the west boundary of 80th Avenue Northeast;
