AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$3,916,824 to the Current Expense Fund balance from the Designated for Contingencies Fund, and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 9720, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$3,916,824 to fund balance, Current Expense Fund, from the Designated for Contingencies Fund.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is added to Ordinance No. 9720 a new section to read as follows:

DESIGNATED FOR CONTINGENCIES - From the Designated for Contingencies Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Designated for Contingencies \$3,916,824

SECTION 3. 1992 actual Current Expense Fund revenue collections in excess of \$281,518,000 that are not required for jail overcrowding reduction measures, or reimbursable expenditures, shall be deposited in the Designated for Contingencies Fund.

SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
