SECTION 1: This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the March 27, 1992, report of the zoning and subdivision examiner, filed with the clerk of the council on April 16, 1992, on the application of James Griffin, to reclassify certain property described in building and land development file no. 112-89-R.

B. A new post-effective Condition 13 is added.

13. A final determination of the allowable number of units shall be made by the Land Use Control Section of BALD before building permits are issued.

Those conditions, if any, must be satisfied on or before three (3) years from the effective date of Council action or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect. Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the building and land development division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
