ORDINANCE NO. 10381

AN ORDINANCE dissolving King County Road Improvement District No. 109 created for the purposes of providing street improvements to a portion of 60th Place Northeast within the Uplake Community.

PREAMBLE:

Pursuant to King County Motion No. 8606, a public hearing was held on May 18, 1992 to dissolve King County Road Improvement District No. 109 created to provide for road improvements on 60th Place Northeast within the plat of Uplake Terrace Addition within the Uplake Community. Notice of said hearing was duly published and mailed to each property owner pursuant to the requirements of R.C.W. 36.88.050 for establishment of a road improvement district. All written and verbal protests were considered. It is further found that all notice requirements of King County Motion No. 8606 have been satisfied.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby dissolved a road improvement district in King County known and designated as "king County Road Improvement District No. 109 (hereinafter "RID No. 109). Said district includes all the territory described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest property corner of lot 18 block 8 Uplake Terrace Addition, thence easterly along the lot lines common to Uplake Terrace Addition and Uplake Manor to the westerly right of way margin of 61st Avenue Northeast, thence southerly along said margin to the southeast property corner of lot 1, block 9 of Uplake Terrace Addition, thence westerly along the right of way margin of Northeast 181st Street to the southeast corner of lot 13 block 8 Uplake Terrace Addition, thence northerly along the east property line of said lot 13 to the northeast property corner of lot 13, thence westerly along the north property line of lot 13 to the northwest corner of lot 13, thence northwesterly along the westerly property line of lots 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 block 8 Uplake Terrace Addition to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: The director of the department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to tabulate costs and expenses for preliminary engineering and administration in conjunction with the work done to date on RID No. 109. Said director is further authorized and directed to recover the costs and expenses of RID No. 109 from any road improvement district created in the future for the purposes of constructing curbs and gutters, sidewalks and street improvements, to the extent such costs and expenses are for work which benefits such later improvements.
