Petitioners: Plum Creek Timber Company and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of County Road #357 hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. County Road #357 was abandoned around 1930 when the existing Lake Sawyer Road (228th Avenue Southeast) was constructed. The department of public works and the real property division have been unable to locate any records regarding ownership or maintenance of this segment of right-of-way. The road is, therefore, classified "D Class" in accordance with King County Code 14.40.060. King County is in receipt of \$200.00 from the petitioners.
- 5. Plum Creek Timber Company owns the property west of County Road #357 and King County owns the property to the east. The Kent School District has expressed an interest in purchasing the two parcels for a future school site. This vacation will remove any interest King County may have in the old right-of-way and allay possible future problems regarding construction on the property.
- 6. During the processing of this vacation, comments were received indicating the existence of a trail along the right-of-way corridor. The parks division has requested that this use be preserved. The department of public works has directed the building and land development division to secure an alternate north-south trail location during the permit and development phases of the property.
- 7. The department of public works considers the old roadway useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the change in public use of the property and the relocation of the trail.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
