2 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$5,400,000 to  
3 the Conservations Futures Fund for  
4 purchase of Options and parcels of land  
5 by King County and the City of Seattle,  
6 and suburban cities, and appropriating  
7 \$1,575,000 to the Open Space Non-Bond  
8 Fund projects and authorizing the  
9 expenditure of \$61,500 from the  
10 Conservation Futures Contingency CIP  
11 Project #316021 for the Vashon Island  
12 Rookery and the Kiwanis Ravine Heron  
13 Rookery Projects, and amending Ordinance  
14 No. 10182, Section 97 and Attachment 2,  
15 as amended.

16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an  
18 appropriation of \$5,400,000 to the Conservation Futures Fund  
19 from unappropriated fund balance for purchase of options and  
20 parcels of land by King County (County CFL Contingency -  
21 \$1,575,000 in Project #315100) and the City of Seattle (Seattle  
22 CFL Contingency - \$1,500,000 in Project #315400) and suburban  
23 cities (Suburban CFL Contingency - \$2,325,000 in Project  
24 #315700).

25 An expenditure of \$22,000 from the Conservation Futures  
26 Contingency Project No. 316021 is authorized for the Maury  
27 Island Heron Rookery and an expenditure of \$39,500 from the  
28 Conservation Futures Contingency Project No. 316021 is  
29 authorized for the Kiwanis Ravine Heron Rookery Project.

30 SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted an  
31 appropriation of \$1,575,000 to the Open Space Non-Bond Fund  
32 from the King County CFL Contingency Fund for purchase of  
33 options and parcels of land by King County:
