

ORDINANCE NO. **10399**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$150,831 to superior court and \$85,806 to judicial administration from Special Programs, Executive Contingency, and amending Ordinance No. 10182, Sections 29 and 31, and 36, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$150,831 to superior court and \$85,806 to judicial administration from Special Programs, Executive Contingency, to support the addition of superior court judges and related staff.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 29, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SUPERIOR COURT - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Superior Court \$150,831

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Superior Court shall be: 2.0

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 31, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Judicial Administration \$85,806

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Judicial Administration shall be: 3.0

SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 10182, Section 36, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

1 SPECIAL PROGRAMS, EXECUTIVE CONTINGENCY - From the Current

2 Expense Fund there is hereby disappropriated from:

3 Special Programs, Executive Contingency (\$236,637)

4 SECTION 5. The county council finds as a fact and declares  
5 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary  
6 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or  
7 safety or for the support of county government and its existing  
8 public institutions.
