ORDINANCE NO. **10409**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of Southeast 240th Street between 116th Avenue Southeast and 140th Avenue Southeast.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The director of the department of public works has made an examination of southeast 240th street between 116th avenue southeast and 140th avenue southeast along a course and description set forth below and has made favorable report upon same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Southeast 240th street shall be established at not less than one hundred feet in width, having fifty feet of such width each side of the following described centerline: commencing at a point on the centerline of 116th avenue southeast, said point being the northwest corner of section 21, township 22 north, range 5 east, W.M. and designated as engineer's station 38+32.05 as surveyed by King County (survey no. 21-22-5-13); thence south 88° 58'25" east 2,646.21 feet to the north quarter corner of section 21, township 22 north, range 5 east, W.M.; thence south 89° 03'53" east 2,644.38 feet to a point on the centerline of 132nd avenue southeast, said point being the northeast corner of said section 21; thence south 89° 00'47" east 2,647.14 feet to a point on centerline of 140th avenue southeast, said point being the north quarter corner of section 22, township 22 north, range 5 east, W.M. and the terminus point of this establishment. 7,937.73 feet=1.50 miles m/l




