ORDINANCE NO. **10443**

AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones; approving a map of the location and boundaries of areas in the Highline School District within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to RCW 69.50.435.

PREAMBLE:

Ordinance 10154 established a procedure for the production or reproduction of maps depicting the location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas within one thousand feet of schools, within which unlawful transactions in controlled substances are subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to RCW 69.50.435. Upon request of the governing body of the Highline School District, King County has prepared a map depicting such boundaries. It is in the public interest to provide notice of the location of such areas and to expedite prosecution, conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of unlawful transactions in controlled substances in such locations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding the following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" thru "L" located within the Highline School District are hereby adopted. The maps produced by the county engineer of the location and boundaries of the drug-free zones surrounding the following schools within the Highline School District, as supported by the Highline School District, are on file with the clerk of the council.
