ORDINANCE NO.

10445

AN ORDINANCE relating to engine compression
brake control areas, amending Ordinance
10070, Section 1, and K.C.C. 46.12.020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to K.C.C. 46.12.020 a new
section to read as follows: B. Prohibition - exception. The
application of engine compression brakes in engine compression
brake control areas is prohibited, except when necessary for
the protection of persons and/or property which cannot be
avoided by application of an alternative braking system. Noise
caused by the application of engine compression brakes which is
effectively muffled or if the application is necessary for the
health, safety, and welfare of the community as specified in
K.C.C. 12.94.010(4) is exempt from the provisions of this
ordinance. Sounds created by emergency equipment for emergency
work are also exempt.
