ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees charged for the use of King County park and recreation facilities fees, and amending Ordinance No. 5225, Section 2(A), as amended, and K.C.C. 7.08.020 and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

- 1. King County has traditionally operated a lifeguarded summer swim beach program with a lifeguard at Lake Garrett located in Lakewood Park.
- 2. The current drought has resulted in an extraordinarily low level of water in the lake, making the designated swimming area too shallow and too small for safe operation, and causing the guarded swim beach program to be canceled for this year.
- 3. King County operates an indoor swimming pool, Evergreen Pool, adjacent to the park and has determined it would be in the best interests of White Center citizens to provide a reasonable alternative to the swim beach program by providing free public swim periods in the pool.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No.1 5225, Section 2(A), as amended,
and K.C.C. 7.08.020 are amended to read as follows:
