## ordinance no 10451

AN ORDINANCE relating to outdoor music festivals, allowing permits to be granted for periods of greater than one day, amending Ordinance 187, Section 3 and K.C.C. 6.52.030 and Ordinance 187, Section 6 and K.C.C. 6.52.060, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The council makes the following findings of fact:

The present county ordinance related to outdoor music festivals limits such events to a single consecutive day in duration. Events which occur on a single day can have impacts on surrounding communities as great or greater than events over One such single-day event, the "KMPS Loyal several days. Listener Festival" has been presented at the King County Fairgrounds annually since 1983. In 1991 40,000 tickets for that event were sold and as a result there was substantial crowding of the fairgrounds and traffic problems associated with the large number of persons attending the event. reduce these impacts for 1992 the sponsor of the event wishes to divide the crowd into two days of no more than 22,000 persons per day. This reduction of impacts will not be possible if the event is limited to a single day. Sufficient time for processing of the necessary permits, advertising and making all other arrangements for the event will difficult, if not impossible if this amendment to the permit ordinance does not take effect immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 187, Section 3, and K.C.C. 6.52.030 are hereby amended to read as follows: Permit fee. The basic fee required shall be seven hundred fifty dollars for each event. ((No-permit shall be granted for a period of more than
