AN ORDINANCE relating to drug-free zones;
approving a map of the location and
boundaries of areas in the Federal Way
School District within which unlawful
transactions in controlled substances are
subject to enhanced penalties pursuant to
RCW 69.50.435 and amending Ordinance
10154, Section 4 and, K.C.C. 12.82.040.

PREAMBLE:

Ordinance 10154 established a procedure for the
production or reproduction of maps depicting the
location and boundaries of parks, schools and areas
within one thousand feet of schools, within which
unlawful transactions in controlled substances are
subject to enhanced penalties as imposed pursuant to
RCW 69.50.435. Upon request of the governing body of
the Federal Way School District, King County has
prepared a map depicting such boundaries. It is in
the public interest to provide notice of the location
of such areas and to expedite prosecution,
conviction, and enhanced penalties for cases of
unlawful transactions in controlled substances in
such locations.

K.C.C. 12.82.040 should be amended to reflect
distribution of the maps of drug-free zones to
agencies required by state law and by needs of
enforcement agencies.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The boundaries of drug-free zones surrounding
the following schools as listed in Exhibits "A" through "H"
located within the Federal Way School District are hereby
adopted:

- A. Camelot Elementary School
- B. Lake Dolloff Elementary and Kilo Junior High Schools
- C. Lakeland Elementary School
- D. North Lake Elementary School
- E. Rainier View elementary School
- F. Valhalla Elementary School
- G. Woodmont Elementary School
- H. Thomas Jefferson High School

The maps produced by the county engineer of the location and
boundaries of the drug-free zones surrounding these schools

1 within the Federal Way School District, as supported by the
 2 Federal Way School District, are on file with the department of
 3 public works, roads and engineering division and the department
 4 of executive administration, records and elections division.

5 SECTION 2. Ordinance 10154, Section 4 and K.C.C.


6 12.82.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

7 Clerk to send notice and ((maintain)) file ((of)) maps. The
 8 clerk of the council shall send notice of adoption of each
 9 ordinance approving a map pursuant of section 12.82.020 or
 10 12.82.030 of this chapter to the clerks of the district and
 11 superior courts, the office of the prosecuting attorney, the
 12 department of public works, ((and)) the police department of
 13 each jurisdiction within which each mapped school or park is
 14 located and the division of records and elections as the
 15 custodian of official county records. ((The clerk is directed
 16 to maintain a current file of all maps which are approved by
 17 the council pursuant to this chapter.))


