AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the Town of Clyde Hill into the King County Rural Library District, and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Town of Clyde Hill, Washington by Ordinance No. 666, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. Since there is no town-appointed library board, the state librarian has been notified per RCW 27.12.360.

Town of Clyde Hill Ordinance No. 666 does satisfy the provisions of RCW 27.12.010(5), and 27.12.360 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1992-7 has concurred with the proposal as submitted on August 17, 1992, all in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 3rd day of November, 1992, within the Town of Clyde Hill. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 27.12.370:

"Shall the Town of Clyde Hill, Washington be annexed to and be part of the King County Rural Library District?"

SECTION 2. Notice of election shall be published as 1 2 required by law. SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and 3 4 declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is 5 necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, or safety or for the support of county government and 6 7 its existing institutions.
