AN ORDINANCE relating to road closure; recognizing the emergency fire hazard conditions on Snoqualmie National Forest lands due to the current drought conditions in the Pacific Northwest and authorizing the installation of a gate and temporary closing of Stossel Creek Road, and declaring an emergency.

ORDINANCE NO.

## PREAMBLE:

King County owns and maintains Stossel Creek Road which accesses Snoqualmie National Forest lands. The severe drought conditions existing in western Washington this year has created an extraordinary fire hazard, making public access to these forest lands a dangerous risk.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Stossel Creek Road shall be closed to the public at such time that the fire danger/risk reaches a minimum threshold for the National Fire Danger Rating System and upon expert opinion of the Department of Natural Resources.

Reopening of the road shall take place when the fire danger/risk falls below this threshold or at the request of Department of Natural Resources.

SECTION 2: During the road closure only residents living along the road and their guests and personnel directly involved in law enforcement, fire prevention, fire detection or suppression shall be permitted on the road.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is
