AN ORDINANCE establishing a School District Impact Fee Fund providing for the receipt and disbursement of School District Impact Fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created a School District Impact Fee Fund. This fund shall be a first tier fund as described in 4.10.010 of the King County Code. This fund shall be a non-budgeted Agency Fund. The Chief Financial Officer shall be the fund manager.

SECTION 2. The School District Impact Fee Fund shall be used for the receipt and disbursement of fees authorized by the State of Washington Growth Management Act of 1990 and 1992, RCW 36.70A and RCW 82.02 and implemented by County Ordinances 9785 and 10162. The School District Impact Fee Fund will be administered under the terms of interlocal agreements between the county and each School District for which an Impact Fee schedule has been adopted by the council.
