AN ORDINANCE relating to traffic control, prohibiting parking between the hours of 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday, except holidays, on both sides of 88th Avenue Northeast, between Simonds Road and Northeast 150th Street, and on both sides of Northeast 152nd Street, between 88th Avenue Northeast and a point approximately 200 feet east of 88th Avenue Northeast, and amending King County Ordinance 5292, Schedule 15, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to traffic engineering studies and as authorized by RCW 46.90, Schedule 15 of King County Ordinance 5292 which prohibits parking during certain times along designated county roads, is amended to add the following roadways:

88TH AVENUE NORTHEAST, on both sides, between Simonds Road and Northeast 150th Street.

NORTHEAST 152ND STREET, on both sides, between 88th Avenue Northeast and a point approximately 200 feet east of 88th Avenue Northeast.

SECTION 2: Signs posted to evidence the above described restriction shall be installed by the proper authority.

SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace,
2 health or safety or for the support of county government and
3 its existing public institutions.


